Our Lower School (grades K–5) supports approximately 125 students, and our Upper School (grades 6–8) supports approximately 200 students.

# Position Description:

Black Pine Circle School assistant teachers work under the supervision of the division head/upper school leadership team. This position is responsible for supporting teachers to help facilitate learning for students. This will include in-class support, working with small groups, and other tasks defined by teachers and the division head.

## Primary Responsibilities:

- Support 18 periods of art (6th 8th grade) weekly
- Work collaboratively with upper school faculty
- Support students with in-class assignments, tasks, and projects
- Support positive classroom management
- Supervise students during recess, lunch, and transition periods
- Assess student work
- Attend weekly faculty meetings as required
- Substitute teacher for classes on an as needed basis
- Other duties as assigned

## School-wide Duties:

- Participate on school committees as needed and appropriate
- Attend all 4-STAR events (school-wide mandatory events)

## Required Qualifications and Skills:

- Experience working with and supervising middle-school aged students preferred
- Ability to take initiative
- Effectively collaborate with faculty and staff
- Interest in professional development in the field of education
- Experience in visual art

#### Compensation:

The anticipated base compensation the school reasonably expects to pay candidates for the position of upper school assistant is \$28.00 to \$32.00 an hour, depending on factors such as experience and education. This position is for the 2023/24 school year, from August 17, 2023 to June 11, 2024.
