

## BPC RELIES ON THE SUPPORT, LEADERSHIP, AND LOYALTY OF MAJOR DONORS TO ACHIEVE ITS FUNDRAISING GOALS

We define "major donors" as households who contribute a minimum of \$1,000 annually and "leadership donors" as those who contribute \$5,000 or more. The school strongly encourages families who can make a gift at the major donor level or higher to do so.

BPC sets a goal of having 50 or more families give at the leadership level or higher every year. The board of directors hosts an invitation-only party to acknowledge major and leadership donors every fall.

#### THE SPRING SOIRÉE FUNDRAISER

Coming together as a community at the Spring Soirée is another great way to have fun and support our school. Proceeds from the event help us to achieve our financial goals. "Raise the Paddle" gifts are counted directly toward the Annual Fund.
